1. CME Evaluation Form (available on www.ABEA.net)

Attendees are required to complete the CME Global Evaluation in order to receive a CME Certificate. The CME Global Evaluation will be available online for attendees once the meeting begins. To receive the CME Certificate, please submit to ABEA no later than Monday, May 21st. **CME Certificates will be emailed to attendees no later than Monday, June 4th.**

2. Self-Assessment Quiz Instructions

- ABEA offers Self-Assessment Credit for each Scientific Session. We are restricted from providing the Self-Assessment quiz prior to each Session.
- Complete the Self-Assessment Session Online Quiz – To complete the online Self-Assessment quiz, you will need receive an email during each Session or visit ABEA's website at www.ABEA.net and click on the CME/Self-Assessment Information drop down link (under Scientific tab).
- Attendees are required to receive a 75% or higher score in order to pass the Self-Assessment quiz, however, you may take the quiz as many times as you would like.
- Self-Assessment quizzes **MUST** be taken within ten days of the end of the ABEA's Annual Meeting, which is **Monday, April 30, 2018**.
- Upon passing your Self-Assessment quiz you will receive a standard certificate which is your receipt for passing and that ABEA has received your results.
- Self-Assessment credit will be included on your CME Certificate which will be emailed no later than Monday, June 4th.

Important Deadline for Claiming Credit

ABEA partners with the American College of Surgeons (ACS) to offer AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ for the ABEA's Annual Meeting. The ACS requires that you complete all meeting evaluations by the dates listed below to receive credit.

May 21, 2018 – All CME evaluations **must be completed** to claim credit and receive your certificate. The ACS requires all CME forms and evaluations be completed within 30 days after the meeting.
